

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY

The eligibility requirements for all Federal Title IV aid and need-based TU aid include:

- Meet federal aid Citizenship Requirements (U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident, or other eligible non-citizen.)
- Students must annually submit a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) and must agree to only use federal student aid for educational purposes
- Must not be in default on a student loan or not owe a repayment of a Federal Title IV grant
- Admission as a bachelor's degree seeking student
- Meet TU's Satisfactory Academic Progress standards
- Must have a valid social security number (except for students from the Republic of the Marshall Islands, Federated States of Micronesia, or the Republic of Palau)
- Male students must register for Selective Service.
- Students must not violate specific federal aid drug conviction restrictions. These restrictions only suspend aid eligibility for students who were convicted of selling or possessing drugs **while they were receiving** federal student aid. Students with convictions that might apply should read this federal process overview, call 1-800-4-FED-AID, or visit the FAFSA website.

Need-based aid programs also require financial need, but Federal Unsubsidized Loans and PLUS Loans do not require financial need.
