

MINOR IN MATHEMATICS

The minor in Mathematics can be completed with 27- 28 units. Some students may complete the minor with up to 32 units depending on the elective courses chosen, some of which are four-unit courses. Minimum four courses in the minor must be taken at Towson University, minimum two of which must be upper-level.
